



# TRAIL GLADES RANGE RULES

Informed by recommendations from health experts, Miami-Dade County is moving to a new normal and easing restrictions on select parks and trails for passive activities and limited recreation.

Patrons are encouraged to use parks for individual and family passive and limited activities.

Current CDC and State Health Department guidelines regarding the use of masks, 6 feet of social distancing between individuals must be followed.

### Miami-Dade County Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces – Limited Activities Use Reminder

- New shooters must participate in the Range Safety Class (Only 5 new shooters will be allowed in the training trailer at one time.)
- Only one person allowed in restrooms at a time.
- All instructional programs or concealed weapons classes have been suspended.
- Tactical range will remain closed for rental.
- Always maintain six feet of separation.
- All guidelines and range rules are subject to change without prior notice.
- Police, park rangers and roving park teams will ensure compliance with these rules and CDC/State Health Department social distancing guidelines and manage park capacities, as necessary. Violators may be subject to applicable fines.

#### Shooter Check In / Registration

- All shooters must wear face coverings when in and around the Pro Shop, Main Range Booth and Restrooms.
- Registration will be conducted one shooter at a time maintaining six feet separation while waiting to check in. Form line outside of entry door at marked intervals.
- Credit Cards are the only form of payment accepted at this time.
- Staff will wear face coverings following CDC guidelines.
- All common areas and equipment are continually disinfected throughout the day to include doors, bathrooms, and all touchable surfaces.
- We encourage shooters to also bring their own hand sanitizer and disinfectant.

#### Firing Line / Fields

- All shooters must always remain at least six feet apart and not share equipment.
- Groups of two or more utilizing same firing lane must always maintain social distance
- Fireline positions have been adjusted to maintain social distance guidelines.
- There is a limit of one team waiting under shelters to participate on the open fields.
- Intentional and deliberate failure to abide by these rules will be subject to suspension of access to the facility.
